Confidential advisor & contact person

Everyone deserves to be able to participate in sports in a safe environment. As a confidential advisor, you are the first point of contact in case of transgressive behaviour. When someone experiences transgressive behaviour, they are often left with many questions and emotions. As a confidential contact person, you can help by listening. You provide a listening ear and inform them about the possible procedures.

Do you have affinity with social safety within sports and are you a good listener that knows how to ask the right questions? Are you discreet, social, sincere and do you hold integrity as a strong value? Then you'll be a good fit as a confidential advisor.

You will be:

- The first point of contact for our members who encounter transgressive behaviour.
- Informing the complainant or accused about the procedures based on the complaint and/or disciplinary regulations.
- Discussing possible referrals to a Center for Safe Sports confidential advisor and/or counsellor, complaint/disciplinary committee of CSN or ISR, lawyer, police and/or other social workers.
- Profiling yourself within CSN, ensuring that everyone within the organisation and all the members are aware of the existence of the confidential advisor and ensures that the rules of conduct of the sport are observed.
- Actively aiding in the prevention of harassment within the sport through preventative activities
- Contributing to policy implementation with regards to national developments in the policy on Sexual Harassment and socially safe sports environment.
- Keeping up to date of (national) developments in the field of prevention and sanctioning of harassment within sport.
